

Dear Parents,

Enclosed you will find your child _____'s Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) Score. This assessment was given to him/her within the first week of school. This assessment is required by the State of Ohio with the intent of measuring their readiness for kindergarten. We are required by the state to share his/her results with you. Based on the Language and Literacy domain of this assessment students are identified as "on track" or "not on track". A score at or above 263 is considered "on track". Based on your child's score in the Language and Literacy domain he/she is identified as:

Please do not be alarmed if your child is identified as "not on track". While the State of Ohio is unable to account for factors surrounding the test such as new surroundings, unfamiliar people asking them questions, and asking students to focus for an extended period of time, we know these played a role in your child's performance.

Please remember this is one piece of data, from the beginning of the year. What is more relevant at this point in the school year is information shared with you at your Parent-Teacher Conference, and other correspondences with the teacher regarding your child's progress. We continuously review our students' progress to ensure we are providing appropriate interventions, if necessary. The entire Liberty Center Staff works together to be sure every child reaches their full potential and this score is just one piece of information that helps the staff determine the types of interventions we need to offer.
